9. A flow of water that can rise or fall with seasonal rainfall. _____
10. A large natural water system, emptying into an ocean, lake, or other body of water. _____
11. A small, natural, gentle stream, usually used in conjunction with the adjective “babbling”. _____
12. A large body of water surrounded by land. _____
